- 22.4 million hogs at any one time in 13,000 factory farms throughout the state ¹
- 22 billion gallons of toxic raw hog sewage spread each year 2
- 750 waterbody impairments 3
- 800 reported manure spills between 1996 2012 4
- 185 beach warnings from 2006 2016 with a record-breaking 37 beach advisories last year 5
- 4.46 million fish killed from animal waste between 1995 2016 6
- 45,700 How many CAFOs Iowa farmland can support 1
